TO ESTABLISH A FIRE DISTRICT THE BOUNDARIES OF WHICH
ARE SET FORTH IN THE WITHIN APPLICATION.

To Guy W. Nichols, H. C. Monta and Issac Howard, of Colchester, in the County
of Chittenden and State of Vermont, and Selectmen of the Town of Colchester, in said
County of Chittenden and State of Vermont : -

We, the undersigned freeholders of said Town of Colchester and residing within
the limits of the proposed fire district as herein bounded and described, do respectfully
petition you as the Selectmen of said Town of Colchester to establish a fire district in said
Town of Colchester of not exceeding two square miles and define its limits and that said
district be designated as fire district number 1 in said Town of Colchester and petition
that the boundaries of said fire district be as follows : -

Northwesterly by a straight line beginning at a point in the northwesterly line of
the Central Vermont Railroad right of way at the easterly line of the City of Winooski;
thence northeasterly along the easterly boundary of the City of Winooski to the southerly
line of the State Militia Grounds; thence easterly along the southerly line of the said State
Militia Ground and the southerly line of the United States Military Post commonly
known as Fort Ethan Allen to the northwesterly line of the said Railroad right of way;
thence along the northerly line of the said Railroad right of way to the point of beginning.
Within the above boundaries the buildings of the Fanny Allen Hospital, the buildings of
St. Michael's College and several dwellings, and other buildings, are located.
